As ordered in 1st Brigade Frag Order Number 135 of 7 November 1965, the 2d Battalion (Airborne), 8th Cavalry became attached to the 3d Brigade on 9 November 1965. At that time the battalion was securing the operations base at STADIUM (YA201342). Security was accomplished by employing Company D on the northern half of the perimeter and Company B on the southern half. Company C constituted the battalion reserve. Local security patrolling was conducted out to 500 meters from STADIUM. Company A had been attached to the 1st Battalion (Airborne), 8th Cavalry and had moved by air to secure the AN KHE Airfield on 8 November. The battalion (-) moved on 10 November by CV-2 and C-123 aircraft from STADIUM to the division base at AN KHE. Movement began at 0800 hours and the battalions closed AN KHE at 2345 hours. A total of 29 CV-2 and five C-123 sorties were used. The battalion was released from attachment to the 3d Brigade upon closing at AN KHE. No problems were encountered during the period of attachment.
